Part 3: The HSBC Overseas Education Grant – Terms and Conditions

1. The HSBC Overseas Education Grant (“the Grant”) is awarded annually by HSBC Bank (Cayman) Limited to a Caymanian student (“the Recipient”) who has shown academic leadership and good character. It will provide assistance to a Caymanian student wishing to pursue a university undergraduate degree overseas.

2. The selection of the Recipient is decided by the HSBC Bank (Cayman) Limited’s (“the Bank”) Scholarship Committee (“the Committee”).

3. Applications will be considered from candidates who have either received notice of acceptance from a college/university overseas or who have already completed their first subsequent year of college/university study.

4. The Bank will provide financial assistance to (2) two Recipients, giving each a grant of USD\$5,000 each for one academic year. The Grant is intended to be used toward standard tuition, student fees, books and supplies. To qualify, candidates must:

- Be Caymanian or hold Caymanian Status
- Aged between 16 and 25 years old and must have the necessary background to achieve success at a competitive college/university
- Demonstrate financial need
- Pursue a business related degree in finance, accounting, insurance, information technology, law or marketing
- Possess a High School Diploma
- Hold a minimum GPA of 3.0 or grade equivalent

5. The Committee will pay special attention to scholastic, sporting and civic attainments, as well as to a candidate’s character and ability to lead.

6. The Grant must only be used toward the degree outlined in the conditional notice of acceptance. A Recipient must complete the full term of study.

7. A Recipient must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 or grade equivalent, keep his/her financing in good standing and maintain a satisfactory standard of behavior at all times.

8. A Recipient will be required to furnish the Committee with a written progress report and official transcripts/grades at the end of each term/semester.

9. The Bank reserves the right to withhold or require repayment of funding in whole or in part in the event of a failure to meet the terms and conditions of this agreement, until such time as all the terms and conditions are met.

10. Payment of the Grant will be awarded in full to a Recipient upon acceptance to the relevant overseas college/university, or immediately where the Recipient has completed their first year of study.

11. A Recipient may hold other scholarships, financial awards or bursaries from local sources, provided that s/he discloses this information beforehand to the Committee. The Committee must be satisfied that the aggregate value of such local awards along with the Grant does not exceed the Committee’s estimate of the cost of tuition, materials and living expenses.

12. A Recipient may re-apply for the Grant following completion of their first year of study and will receive first preference based on academic standing at the college/university .

13. The Committee reserves the right to withhold the Grant for any reason.

14. Should a Recipient wish to change his/her degree of study at any time, s/he must notify the Bank immediately as to the intended change. In such circumstances, the Bank reserves the right to immediately withdraw funding.

15. Recipients are required to give a written undertaking that if awarded the Grant they will return to the Cayman Islands on completion of their studies and render services to the community for a time equal to the period of the grant.

16. The application must be made on the attached form and must be accompanied by:

- Recent full face photograph
- Copy of birth certificate and/or certificate of Caymanian Status
- High school and/or college/university transcript(s)
- CV/Resume
- Three letters of character reference (one from school)
- Conditional notice of acceptance to a college/university overseas
- Letter(s) of acceptance for other scholarships, financial awards or grants awarded by other financial institutions or bodies
- Essay of 400 words on why you have chosen to pursue the outlined course of study
