## Part 3: The HSBC Local Scholarship – Terms and Conditions

1. The HSBC Local Scholarship (“the Scholarship”) is awarded annually by HSBC Bank (Cayman) Limited to a Caymanian student (“the Recipient”) who has shown academic leadership and good character. It will provide assistance to a Caymanian student wishing to pursue an Associate or Bachelors Degree from a local college/university.

2. The selection of the Recipient is decided by the HSBC Bank (Cayman) Limited’s (“the Bank”) Scholarship Committee (“the Committee”).

3. Applications will be considered from candidates who have either received notice of acceptance from a local college/university or who have already completed their first subsequent year of study from a local college/university.

4. Associates Degree Scholarships – The Bank will award (2) two Associate Degree Scholarships annually. These grants will provide financial assistance of USD\$4,000 to complete a first degree over a period not exceeding two years.

5. Bachelors Degree Scholarships – The Bank will award (1) one Bachelor Degree Scholarship annually. The Bank will provide financial assistance of USD\$9,000 to complete a Bachelor Degree over a period not exceeding two years.

6. The Scholarship is intended to be used toward standard tuition, student fees, books and supplies. To qualify, a candidate must:

- a) Be Caymanian or hold Caymanian Status
- b) Be aged between 16 and 25 years old and must have the necessary background to achieve success at a competitive college
- c) Demonstrate financial need
- d) Pursue a business related degree in finance, accounting, insurance, information technology, law or marketing
- e) Have received a conditional notice of acceptance from a local college/university
- f) Possess a High School Diploma
- g) Hold a minimum GPA of 3.0 or grade equivalent

7. The Committee will pay special attention to scholastic, sporting and civic attainments, as well as to a candidate’s character and ability to lead.

8. The Scholarship will be awarded on a basis of merit.

9. Funds awarded through the Scholarship must be used toward the degree outlined in the conditional notice of acceptance from a local college/university.

10. The Recipient must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 or grade equivalent, keep his/her financing in good standing and maintain a satisfactory standard of behavior at all times.

11. The Recipient will be required to furnish the Committee with a written progress report and official transcripts/grades at the end of each term/semester.

12. The Bank reserves the right to withhold or require repayment of funding in whole or in part in the event of a failure to meet the terms and conditions of this agreement, until such time as all the terms and conditions are met.

13. The Committee reserves the right to withhold the award of a Scholarship for any reason.

14. The Recipient of the Scholarship must not hold or accept any other scholarship. If this should occur, the Committee reserves the right to withdraw any financial assistance.

15. Upon completion of two years should the Recipient wish to continue in the Scholarship they must re-apply and will receive preference based on academic standing.

16. The application must be made on the attached form and must be accompanied by:

- a) Recent full face photograph
- b) Copy of birth certificate and/or certificate of Caymanian Status
- c) High school and/or college/university transcript(s)
- d) CV/Resume
- e) Three letters of character reference (one from school)
- f) Conditional notice of acceptance to a local college/university
- g) Essay of 400 words on why you have chosen to pursue the outlined course of study
